



**Call for Applications for the Selection of Regular Students for the Stricto Sensu Postgraduate Programme in Electrical Engineering at Master and Doctorate Levels**  
*(Approval: Decision CPG nº 76/2024 and Resolution of the Congregation FEEC nº 260/2024)*

**1st SEMESTER 2024**

The School of Electrical and Computer Engineering (FEEC) of the State University of Campinas (UNICAMP) announces the registration for the selective process of admission of regular students starting in the First Semester of 2024 in the Stricto Sensu Postgraduate Programme in Electrical Engineering.

The programme offers Master's and Doctoral Levels in the area of specialisation: Automation (AA); Electronics, Microelectronics and Optoelectronics (AC); Biomedical Engineering (AD); Computer Engineering (AE); Electrical Energy (AF) and Telecommunications and Telematics (AG).

**APPLICATION CALENDAR**

1st Phase: Registration of the candidate: October 1 to October 31, 2024

2nd Phase: Candidate selection: November 4 to November 30, 2024

3rd Phase: Disclosure of results: December 29, 2024

4th Phase: Confirmation of interest in matriculation: January 6 to January 24, 2025

5th Phase: Matriculation of accepted students: February 3 to February 5, 2025

**PRE-REQUISITES**

**Candidates who have completed their undergraduate course at a Higher Education Institution (HEI)** in Brazil or abroad, are eligible as regular students for the Postgraduate Programme in Electrical Engineering.

**PROCEDURES FOR APPLICATION**

**Candidates must read carefully all the information contained in this call for applications, as incorrect procedures may make the application impossible. Late applications will not be accepted.**

Applications must be made exclusively through the Academic Management System, available on the website of the Academic Directorate (DAC):

## DOCUMENTS FOR APPLICATION

In addition to the registration on the DAC website, the candidate must upload his/her documents in PDF format to the system of the School of Electrical and Computer Engineering within the stipulated deadline.

Candidates who do not attach documentation within the registration period will have their registration automatically rejected.

The obligatory documents are:

### ➤ Master's Degree

- ❖ Application Form (generate a PDF file from the DAC's online form, after completing the application process via the Academic Management System)
- ❖ Curriculum Vitae (preferably Lattes Curriculum Vitae in PDF format)
- ❖ Undergraduate Academic Records
- ❖ Diploma/ Certificate of Conclusion / Declaration of Probable Graduate \*
- ❖ Indicate, in the system of the School of Electrical and Computer Engineering, two persons as references (e.g., former professors) providing name, e-mail address and educational institution.

\* A candidate who does not possess a diploma may attach a certificate of completion of studies or a statement of possible completion of studies issued by the university with the probable date of completion during the matriculation period.

In case the applicant is accepted, he/she must present the diploma or certificate of completion at the time of matriculation. Unicamp undergraduate students must attach the document of completion of studies issued by the Academic Directorate.

### ➤ Doctoral Degree

- ❖ Application Form (generate a pdf file from the DAC's online form, after completing the application process via the Academic Management System)
- ❖ Curriculum Vitae (preferably Lattes Curriculum Vitae in PDF format).
- ❖ Undergraduate Academic Records
- ❖ Postgraduate Academic Records
- ❖ Undergraduate Diploma
- ❖ Master's Diploma \*\*
- ❖ Indicate, in the system of the School of Electrical and Computer Engineering, two persons as references (e.g., former professors) providing name, e-mail address and educational institution.

\*\* Candidates without a Master's diploma may attach, during the application period, the Certificate of Completion, the letter of defence of the thesis or a statement from the supervisor stating the date of the defence of the thesis.

## SELECTION

Candidates are selected independently by each department of the School of Electrical and Computer Engineering. Therefore, candidates may indicate up to two departments that best meet their research interests. Interviews with candidates may be scheduled from time to time.

Candidates should find out which departments are developing projects in the areas of specialisation and lines of research they are interested in. It is also advisable to consult the list of professors with keywords and contact details.

It is recommended that candidates contact the professors of the departments they are interested in, in order to provide additional information to assist in the selection process.

## SCHOLARSHIPS

**Candidates with an employment contract will not be able to opt for the scholarships.**

- Programme Scholarship

The candidate must express interest in the programme scholarship when completing the application form. Approval of the candidate does not guarantee a scholarship from the programme. The availability of scholarships in each semester depends primarily on the number of places released by the funding agencies.

A candidate who is not awarded a scholarship in a given semester may participate in the priority list in the following semester and reapply for a programme fee scholarship.
